Haldimand County is rich with opportunity for physicians and health care professionals, with two acute care hospitals and a vibrant, growing Family Health Team.

Our hospitals are located in Dunnville and Hagersville and offer inpatient services, a wide array of outpatient clinics, surgical programs, busy emergency departments, and imaging services that include x-ray, mammography, ultrasound, bone density, and CT. There are many opportunities for physicians, especially in family medicine and emergency medicine.

Haldimand Family Health Team (FHT) is a collaborative, team-based family health team. It operates from multiple locations across Haldimand County, with offices in Dunnville, Hagersville, and Caledonia. Physicians are affiliated with the FHT through several Family Health Organizations. The FHT team includes independent health professionals to support physicians and the community and offers over 20 programs. Other professionals include Nurse Practitioners, Social Workers, RNs, a Respiratory Educator, Dietitians, Kinesiologist and System Navigator.

Haldimand County is considered an underserved community. As a result, we are actively seeking new physicians to both practice and live in our community, and have worked to increase integrated care services and pathways to support practices. Haldimand is part of the Greater Hamilton Health Network (an Ontario Health Team) that has developed a Primary Care Leadership Network and brings healthcare practitioners together regularly to be engaged in health system planning and co-design.

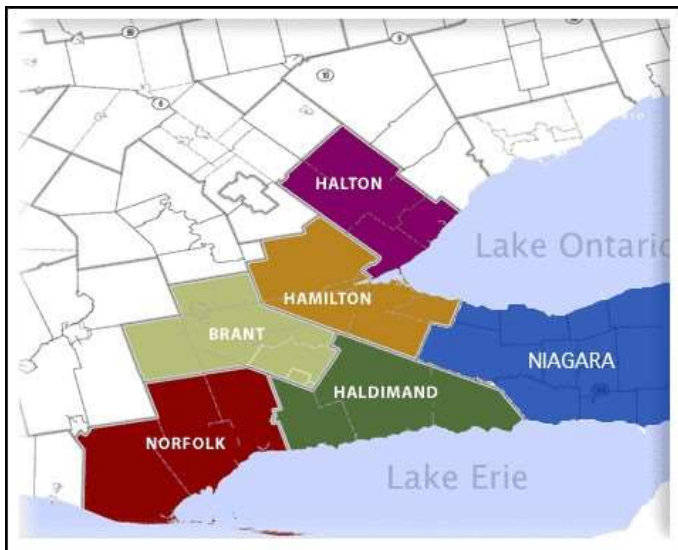
