Temporary Full-Time Summer Student Maintenance

Job Summary:

Reporting to the Director of Plant Maintenance, Engineering & Environmental Services, the seasonal summer student for exterior grounds maintenance will provide good work ethics, the ability to work independently, and has proven experience operating all types of lawn and garden equipment. Other duties may be assigned periodically under the discretion of the Director. This position includes responsibilities across the entire healthcare campus. * This position is part of the Canada Summer Jobs program.

Hours of Work: This temporary position commences immediately and ends August 31st, 2024. This position is 37.5 hours per week, Monday to Friday. A typical shift is 0800 to 1600 hours.

Qualifications:

Applicants should:

- Be currently enrolled in a post-secondary/college/university educational program.
- Be between the age of 15 and 30 at the start of employment. * Canada Summer Jobs program
- Demonstrates experience in performing lawn and garden maintenance.
- Ability to safely operate various pieces of power equipment (ie., lawnmower, gas trimmer).
- Demonstrates good assessment and independent time management skills.
- Be able to lift up to 25 kg unassisted.
- Demonstrates knowledge of safety requirements related to position.
- Familiarity with usage of pertinent PPE as required for the role (ie., safety shoes, glasses).
- Communicating & collaborating with the interprofessional team.
- Documentation related to the patient care they provide.
- Reporting changes in patient status to the most responsible nurse for best patient care.
